*HB 56: Condominium Amendments*

**Background:** This bill authorizes the Office of Property Rights Ombudsman to advise condominium owners and conduct or arrange for mediation or arbitration of disputes between condominium owners and condominium associations and requires condominium associations to register and pay a fee annually.

**UH&LA Position:** Against

*SB 15: Off-highway Vehicle Amendments*

**Background:** This bill increases the cap on the registration fee amount that the Board of Parks and Recreation may establish for off-highway vehicle (\$18) and snowmobile registrations (\$26).

**UH&LA Position:** Monitoring

*SB 314: Wage Reporting Amendments*

**Background:** requires an employer to include additional wage-related information on quarterly unemployment contribution reports filed with the Unemployment Insurance Division including occupation title and hours worked for each paid employee during the calendar quarter.

**UH&LA Position:** Monitoring

*SB 129: Unemployment Insurance Modifications*

**Background:** This bill modifies the Employment Security Act by reducing the maximum unemployment insurance contribution rate for an employer (from 9% to 7%) beginning in calendar year 2012 and capping the social unemployment insurance contribution rate for all employers (at 0.4%) for calendar year 2012 only.

**UH&LA Position:** Monitoring
